Commentary for the guarter ending 31 March 2018

Cash receipts from customers for the March 2018 quarter were \$2.18m, a decrease of \$163k or 7% on the previous quarter's receipts of \$2.34m.

Payments during the quarter at \$5.52m were in line with the forecast of \$5.45m and higher on the previous quarter by \$244k or 5%. As forecast, the increase was driven by increased publisher payments which were \$263k higher than the previous quarter.

Net cash used in operating activities for the quarter was \$3.33m, 505k (18%) higher than the previous quarter at \$2.83m.

Cash at the end of the March 2018 quarter was \$4.58m, with an additional \$2.7m to be collected via the R&D Rebate Scheme within the June 2018 quarter (for R&D expenditure incurred in FY2017). The Company had forecast collection of this amount in the March quarter, with delay in receipt due to a later than expected completion of its submission in that quarter.

The Company expects further funds collected via the R&D Rebate Scheme for FY2018 to exceed FY2017, and expects payment of those funds in either the September or December 2018 quarters. In total, amounts received via this scheme are expected to exceed \$6.0m over coming quarters.

The forecast for June 2018 payments is \$5.22m which is \$304k or 6% below current quarter. Some of the benefits of the Cost Reduction Plan announced on 27 February 2018 are reflected in the March 2018 quarter. The majority of the cost savings will be evident in June and September quarters.

Although the Company continues to make progress towards realising material trading fee revenue (please see Trading Update issued today), due to the delay of significant trading fee revenue growth to date, the Company has explored and is currently considering a range of capital management initiatives.
